CENTENARY OF FEDERATION LAUNCH

BE WATERWISE!



Water restrictions still apply in the Goldfields. The restrictions apply to watering of gardens using sprinklers and reticulation systems. The Water Corporation is also encouraging residents to reduce water consumption wherever possible including in and around the home (see page 3 for ways to conserve water around the home).

Waterwise Gardening

If sprinklers need to be used in the garden, make sure you adhere to your two allocated days per week. Please note that sprinklers are **not to be used** between the hours of **9.00am - 6.00pm**. A high percentage of water evaporates from watering during these hours and watering during the heat of the day is not beneficial to the garden. **Please use water wisely.**
